It could be a known superhero, a made-up superhero, or a person who leads by example."



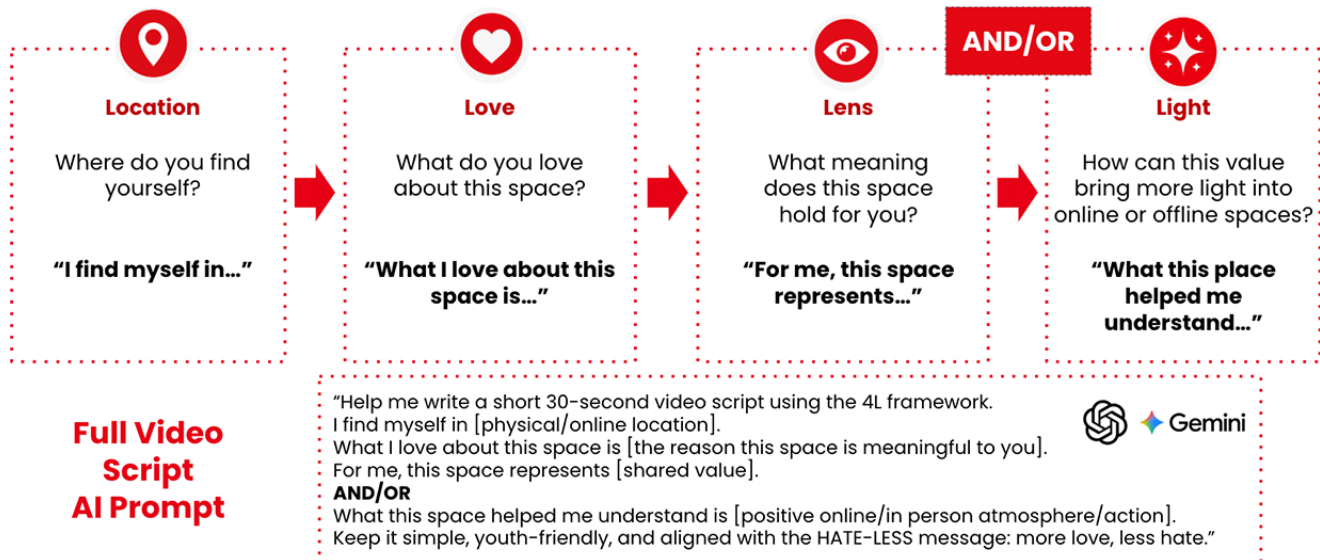
Step 2 - Tool + Creation of Video Script

Step 3 & 4 - Choose Your Space - 4L Video Spark



One space + one value + one message = one short Reel

Step 5 - Act of Courage! Record the Reel

Recording tips

1. **Record vertically** if you are using a phone.
2. **Start with the space** so the location matters visually.
3. **Use natural light** or a ring light if possible. Face the light instead of sitting with strong light behind you.
4. **Stabilize your phone or camera** by using a tripod or placing it on a steady surface.
5. **Keep one clear message:** one location, one shared value, one positive online message.
6. **Protect privacy:** avoid showing addresses, documents, private screens, private messages, usernames, or people who have not given consent.
7. **Speak clearly and keep it natural:** use your own voice, go slowly, and do not aim for perfection.

Video Rules for Feature

1. **Reflect HATE-LESS values:** respect, inclusion, empathy, and more love, less hate.
2. **Keep it safe:** positive, respectful, and non-political.
3. **Protect privacy/GDPR:** only include yourself; no children, personal data, private screens, or other people without consent.
4. **Upload here:** HATE-LESS 1/4 - Storytelling Through Space - Videos
5. **Publication:** Videos may be used for project communication only with your consent.
